

**Provisions of Sample Domestic Relations Order  
Participant in Pay Status**

It is the intent of the Court that the provisions of this domestic relations order ("Order") operate as an effective assignment of the Participant's interest in the Pension Fund set forth below to the Alternate Payee under both state and federal laws, for all, and constitute a Qualified Domestic Relations Order ("QDRO") in compliance with section 414(p) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("Code") and Section 206(d)(3) of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, as amended ("ERISA").
