

## DISTRICT COURT STATE OF OKLAHOMA DIVORCE PACKET

### NO CHILDREN - WITH PROPERTY AND/OR ASSETS (Incompatibility)

This forms package is intended to assist you in obtaining an uncontested divorce in Oklahoma. Please note that these materials may not be appropriate in all situations. In addition, the information and forms contained herein are not a substitute for the advice of an attorney. If you have questions, you should consult with an attorney licensed to practice law in Oklahoma.

This packet contains the following:

1. Instructions for completing the forms;
2. Petition for Divorce;
3. Summons;

This is the form you serve on the other party with the other documents to let them know you that they have been sued. However, if the other party signs the Waiver of Service and Entry of Appearance (see attachments), you may not be required to use the Summons.

4. Automatic Temporary Injunction;

5. Entry of Appearance and Waiver;

If the other spouse completes the Waiver of Service of Process and returns it, the Waiver should then be filed with the clerk and no official Summons will issue to that spouse. If the other spouse does not complete the Waiver of Process form, then a Summons is issued directing the Defendant to Answer the Petition.

6. Final Decree of Divorce;

7. Notice of Entry of Decree;

8. Separation and Property Settlement Agreement, and

9. Non-Military Affidavit.

You and your spouse must be in agreement to all terms of the divorce to use this packet.
